## Project scope

Wiley worked collaboratively with Quintrex to successfully build their industrial facility at Coomera. Due to the successful partnership on that project, Telwater engaged Wiley to deliver an innovative roofing system many years later.

Wiley undertook urgent roof repairs and maintenance over four days, with an urgent turn around required. The project involved:

- Remove and replace all Alsynite sheeting to ensure structural integrity
- Remove and replace damaged roof sheeting to prevent future issues
- Replace all roof screws to ensure watertight protection
- Upgrade box gutters with stainless steel, enhancing durability and functionality
- Power wire breezeway louvers to eliminate rust, as the facility is in close proximity to the Gold Coast waterways
- Remove loose paint, then recoat in a 2 Pack paint system insitu to improve aesthetics
- Wash down entire roof area
